

# 4-H Saskatchewan Ambassador Program

### What is a 4-H Ambassador?

Ambassadors are members and leaders who showcase the true spirit of 4-H Saskatchewan through their willingness to volunteer and share their knowledge of the 4-H program. Ambassadors will focus on strengthening 4-H Saskatchewan through public relations by recruiting new members, representing 4-H Saskatchewan at local events, and sharing their 4-H story in a positive and inclusive way.

## To apply, candidates must:

- 1. Complete the application and send it to the 4-H Office **before** March 11, 2024.
- 2. Be ready to show your 4-H spirit to the rest of the province!



#### How will Ambassadors be chosen?

Profiles for submitted candidates will be provided to voting attendees at the Annual General Meeting. During each regional meeting, voting delegates will elect six representatives from the candidates. You DO NOT need to attend AGM to be considered for an Ambassador role!

# Points to consider as you apply for the 4-H Saskatchewan Ambassador program

- The purpose of the Ambassador program is to:
  - Enhance and promote 4-H
  - Create awareness of opportunities in 4-H
  - Improve the 4-H program through leadership
  - Act as a focus group for 4-H youth and leader ideas and concerns
- Ambassadors will gain:
  - Leadership opportunities and skills
  - Teamwork successes
  - Personal confidence
  - Specialized Ambassador training
- Ambassadors must:
  - Attend ONE training session (either online or in person)
  - Participate in approved activities throughout the year
  - Follow the 4-H Canada Code of Conduct and fulfill the duties of the Ambassador Program as outlined in the Ambassador Participation form

- Ambassador duties may include:
  - Attending non-4-H events to promote 4-H at schools, community registration days, and other community activities
  - Organizing a community event to raise community support
  - Assisting the 4-H office in promoting events and learning key 4-H messaging to share with non-4-H audiences
  - Writing articles about 4-H events for publication in local or regional publications
- Ambassadors are NOT expected to:
  - attend provincial board meetings
  - carry in depth knowledge of 4-H policies
  - help plan programs
  - o run workshops
  - help with conflict management
- Ambassadors are encouraged, but NOT expected, to attend provincial 4-H programs
