A \$250 purchase certificate will be awarded for the Grand Champion steer or female, and a \$100 purchase certificate to the Reserve Champion steer or female at regional shows, plus a promotional gift. The animal must be one half or better Shorthorn breeding and show strong Shorthorn characteristics. Shorthorn breeding must be stated at the time of entry. The purchase certificate will be honoured provided the animal is purchased at any Shorthorn Association sanctioned sale in Saskatchewan and expires December 31st of the following year. Members MUST provide their name, address, hard copy picture, 5"x7" and a letter of accomplishment to Betty NO LATER than September 1st.
