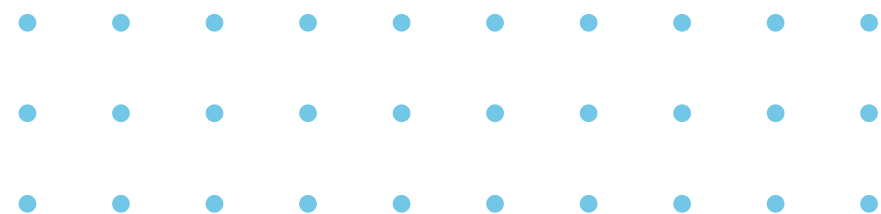

## **PLEASE NOTE:**

- These awards are offered by 4-H Saskatchewan.
- This document will go through who is eligible for each scholarship based on their tenure with 4-H, post-secondary program of choice, and other factors.
- Please read this document carefully to determine which awards you can apply for.
- Please also note the additional requirements for some awards, and ensure that you complete these and send them with your application.

**\*\* Although you may not be eligible, we encourage you to apply anyways, as there may be special circumstances that result in your application being considered for that scholarship.\*\***

## **TERMINOLOGY:**

- Entrepreneurial refers to: The process of starting a business or organization; Research development in one's field of study; Contributing to an entrepreneurial endeavour; possessing entrepreneurial aspirations.
- Entering meaning the first year the applicant has enrolled in any post-secondary educational institution.
- Continuing meaning applicant must be currently enrolled in a program and returning for the next available study period.
- Completing meaning applicant is at the end of a one year program that does not continue into another study period, or is in the final year of studies.



# THE ENTREPRENEURIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Three awards at \$3,000 each. Created by Mr. Bill Cooper

Through the generosity and insight of Mr. William (Bill) Cooper, P.Ag., 3 scholarships valued at \$3,000 each are available to current or past 4-H members (including Future Leaders) who demonstrates exceptional enthusiasm for, and awareness of, the entrepreneurial concept. Students entering or continuing their studies in a degree, diploma, certificate, or graduate studies program at any level of post-secondary education at any post-secondary institution are eligible to apply. Preference will be given to current 4-H members and Future Leaders.

## Preferences:

- Preference given to applicants **entering or continuing** in a business or agribusiness program but members entering or continuing in any field of study are encouraged to apply.
- Preference given to **current members** (including Future Leaders age category).
- Applicants who are completing their program **are not eligible** to apply.

## Other Requirements:

- Include a **resume** of your academic, extra-curricular, volunteer, and work experience
- Include a **maximum 500 word "Entrepreneurial" essay** on the topic "How and why are business and entrepreneurial skills needed in your field of study". Demonstrate exceptional enthusiasm for, and awareness of, the entrepreneurial concept.

# THE SOUTH COUNTRY EQUIPMENT SCHOLARSHIP

Eight awards at \$2,500 each. Supported by South Country Equipment

We encourage youth to pursue post-secondary education so they can take advantage of the local career opportunities, which in turn continue to support and grow the communities we all enjoy- right here in Saskatchewan. 4-H is based upon principles that are important to us well as our customers. This scholarship is an excellent way to combine our support for education with our support for the youth in the communities we serve, and continue our legacy of supporting 4-H in Saskatchewan.

## Preferences:

- Given to first year students.
- Preference given to applications from Assiniboia, Mossbank, Moose Jaw, Southey, Raymore, Regina/Emerald Park, Montmartre and Weyburn areas.

## Other Requirements:

- Successful applicants must be from with the South Country Equipment trade area, as based on RM.
- Must come from a rural/farm background. Complete "Rural/Farming Background" section of the Scholarship Application.

# THE SASKATCHEWAN 4-H FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

Two awards at \$2,000 each. Supported by the Saskatchewan 4-H Foundation

This scholarship was created by the Saskatchewan 4-H Foundation. The Saskatchewan 4-H Foundation has played a significant role in the success of 4-H Saskatchewan for over 60 years. The Foundation was incorporated in 1960 for the purpose of receiving and administering funds donated to the 4-H program. It became a charitable organization in 1967. The Foundation receives donations from a wide variety of sources which are dispersed throughout the 4-H program to improve our 4-H member's experiences.

## Preferences:

- This scholarship will emphasize active involvement in 4-H and in the community.

## Other Requirements:

- Must be a current member.

# THE HOLLAND FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

Two awards at \$2,000 each. Created by the Holland Family

The Holland Family has provided this scholarship in honour of Kent and Myrla Holland, long-time leaders. The Holland Family believes in the life lessons “learned to do by doing” within 4-H and because of this have created this scholarship. Applicants must be entering the second or subsequent year of their program; those in the first year of a graduate program are also eligible. They also must be enrolled in agriculture, agri-business or a related profession/trade.

## Preferences:

- Preference given to applicants in the **second or subsequent year of their program**. Must be enrolled in an agriculture, agribusiness, or related profession/trade.
- Preference is given to applicants attending programs in **Saskatchewan or Saskatchewan residents studying out of province**.
- Applicants who are in their first year of their program **are also eligible**.

## Other Requirements:

- Must submit **post-secondary transcripts** and have an academic achievement in the program **at or above 2.0 GPA/70%/C**

# THE (SCA) SASKATCHEWAN CATTLEMEN'S ASSOCIATION AWARD

One award at \$2,000. Supported by the Saskatchewan Cattlemen's Association

The Saskatchewan Cattlemen's Association was established in 2009 with the mandate to provide a united voice for the province's beef industry, with representation from all industry sectors and across all regions of the province. This scholarship was created to provide one \$2,000 award to an active 4-H member who aims for a career in the beef cattle industry.

## Preferences:

- Preference given to applicants entering or continuing post-secondary education (university or college) related to the beef industry.

## Other Requirements:

Must submit a maximum 500 word essay which identifies:

- One challenge facing the beef industry and a suggestion to overcome that challenge.
- Identify the program the applicant will enter in the coming academic year.
- How that program will help them to enter a career in the beef industry.

# THE BRANDT AGRICULTURE SCHOLARSHIP

Five awards at \$1,500 each. Supported by participating Brandt Dealerships

The Brandt Agriculture Scholarship for 4-H'ers offers five scholarships of \$1,500 to students entering their first or second year of an agriculture-related degree, diploma, certificate or trade program. Applicants must come from a rural/farm background. Brandt is proud to support the development of local 4-H members pursuing higher education related to advancing the growing agriculture industry.

## Preferences:

- Preference will be given to applicants whose **parent(s) are active** in the farming/agriculture industry.
- Preference will be given to those residing in the **Melfort, Prince Albert, Saskatoon, Watrous, or Rosthern areas.**

## Other Requirements:

- **Must come from a rural/farm background.** Complete "Rural/Farming Background" section of the Scholarship Application.
- **Must demonstrate financial need.** Complete the "Financial Need" section of the Scholarship Application.

# THE SASAKTCHEWAN POLYTECHNIC VETERINARY TECHNOLOGY DIPLOMA - DISTANCE OFFERING

One award at \$1,500. Created by Saskatchewan Polytechnic

The Saskatchewan Polytechnic Veterinary Technology program offers a rural and remote cohort. A few years ago, the Ministries of Advanced Education and Agriculture announced initiatives to enhance the availability of veterinary services in rural Saskatchewan. These included the development of a new virtual option to train registered veterinary technologists in rural and remote parts of the province, as well as a loan forgiveness program that will be offered to new graduates who practice in rural or remote communities.

Sask Polytech’s two-year registered veterinary technologist program will allow students to begin their studies remotely and complete the program at a partnering clinical practice with local veterinarians in rural areas. This cohort will take the didactic portion of the program virtually with the in-person students, and work with a partnering Vet Clinic to complete the lab-based courses. Sask Polytech hopes to offer this scholarship to support those living in a rural remote community that are considering a career in Veterinary Technology. We are targeting the Distance option to help meet the needs of more Veterinary Technicians in Rural Saskatchewan.

## Preferences:

- The scholarship does not have any specific preferences.

## Other Requirements:

- Write a **250-500 word "Career in Agriculture" statement** that answers "How will your post-secondary education help you to pursue a career in agriculture and how will this help contribute to and advance the agriculture industry?"
- Must demonstrate **financial need**. Complete the "Financial Need" section of the Scholarship Application.

# THE HECTOR LOVERIDGE MEMORIAL FUND SCHOLARSHIP

One award at approximately \$1,000. Created by the Loveridge Family

One scholarship of approximately \$1,000 (pending funds available through the endowment) which is provided by the family of Hector Loveridge and held by the Saskatoon Community Foundation. This is a University of Saskatchewan entrance Scholarship for students entering the College of Agriculture in a degree or diploma course.

## Preferences:

- The scholarship does not have any specific preferences.

## Other Requirements:

- Applicants shall have a solid academic record, but need not necessarily be the top student.
- Students should be well rounded through involvement in school and/or community activities.

\*\* Note: Exact value varies determining on the value available from the Endowment Fund. Approximately \$1,000.

# THE GORDON & EILEEN BONNOR SCHOLARSHIP

One award at \$1,000. Created by Gordon & Eileen Bonnor

This Scholarship Fund was created by Gordon & Eileen Bonnor in 2015 to encourage continued studies relating to agriculture or associated careers. The late Gordon Bonnor's history with 4-H and teaching went back to 1954 and Eileen Bonnor worked for many years with the Crop Science Department at the University of Saskatchewan.

## Preferences:

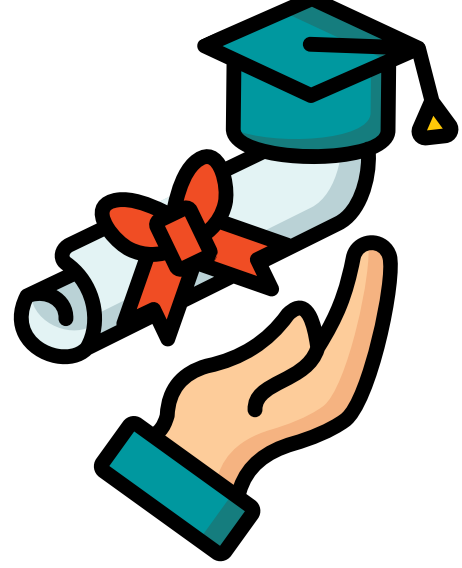
- Preference for those from a **rural/farm background** who showcase direct involvement and experience within Saskatchewan 4-H. Complete "Rural/Farming Background" section of the Scholarship Application.
- Applicants must be completing Grade 12 or completed Grade 12 previously.
- Must have been a Saskatchewan 4-H members **for at least 3 years** and have been a member within the last 2 years.

## Other Requirements:

- Must demonstrate **financial need**. Complete the "Financial Need" section of the Scholarship Application.
- Include a **resume** of your academic, extra-curricular, volunteer and work experience.
- Write a **maximum 500 word "Bonnor Award" essay** based on your community involvement, leadership, extra-curricular participation, and how you contribute to the success of your family farm.

# THE LORNE MCCONAGHY SENIOR 4-H MEMBER PUBLIC SPEAKING SCHOLARSHIP

One award at \$1,000. Created by Lorne McConaghy

This scholarship was created by Lorne McConaghy to acknowledge a Senior 4-H member who has participated at either Regional or Provincial Public Speaking. Lorne recognizes that 4-H encompasses more than the yearly projects and hopes that this scholarship can highlight the public speaking aspect of 4-H, which assists in the development of youth's confidence.

## Preferences:

- The applicant must have participated as a **Senior member at Regional and/or Provincial Public Speaking.**

## Other Requirements:

- Applicant must have a **minimum of 3 years** of 4-H membership.
- Students will need to demonstrate their involvement in 4-H, extra-curricular activities, and in the community.

# THE MCCONAGHY SCHOLARSHIP

One award at \$1,250. Supported by the McConaghy Family of Beatty, SK

This scholarship was provided by the McConaghy family for a current 4-H member entering a Business, Economics, Agriculture degree program at the University of Regina or University of Saskatchewan. This scholarship will emphasize active involvement in 4-H and in community and extra-curricular activities.

The McConaghy family has been involved in 4-H with the Beatty 4-H Beef Club since the 1950's. Trevis McConaghy currently funds six awards in Saskatchewan. He believes in giving back to the organizations that have been a part of his success.

## Preferences:

- This scholarship will emphasize active involvement in 4-H, in the community, and extra-curricular activities.

## Other Requirements:

- Must demonstrate **financial need**. Complete the "Financial Need" section of the Scholarship Application.
- Must come from a **rural/farm background**. Complete "Rural/Farming Background" section of the Scholarship Application.

# THE PALLISER INSURANCE 4-H SCHOLARSHIP

Two awards at \$500 each. Supported by Palliser Insurance

These scholarships are available to 4-H members entering any degree/diploma/certificate program. It can be used at a University or any other post secondary institution. These scholarships are open to all 4-H members in Saskatchewan regardless of place of residence, and will be reviewed with heavy emphasis on people skills, leadership skills, goals and ambition with less emphasis on academic history.

## Preferences:

- Preference given to applicants who are current registered Saskatchewan 4-H members
- Has been a 4-H Saskatchewan member for the last 2 years.

## Other Requirements:

- No other requirements are required for applicants.

- 4-H Saskatchewan also maintains a list of scholarships that 4-H'ers are eligible for (but are not exclusively for 4-H'ers) on our website under "Opportunities" > "Other Scholarships". These awards have varying deadlines—make sure to check with the scholarship provider for full details on their award.
- Check with your high school or post-secondary institution to see if they offer scholarships, or if they maintain a list of scholarship opportunities.
