



## COVID Considerations for your 4-H Public Speaking event:

- Members may remove their masks when speaking
- If a microphone is being used, spray it with sanitizer between each speaker
- Sanitize any prop tables that are used, and have anyone adjusting the microphone to sanitize their hands in between uses
- Have an extra mic for your MC so you don't have to sanitize quite as much
- If serving food, make sure everything is individually wrapped, or have one person serve. Some groups are opting to not serve food. Also have sanitizer handy.
- Regarding programs, either lay them out on all the seats prior to the competition, or have one person hand them out as people arrive. Don't have them in a stack that people can grab.
- Try not to have any 'common touch' areas – registration sheets at registration table, tickets that people have to fill out, etc.
- You could consider social distancing your audience a bit – maybe have people sit in cohorts/families. You may also want to give your judges a bit more space.
