Fairy Garden

Supplies

- Terracotta Pot (or similar)
- Paint
- Paintbrushes
- Potting soil
- Rocks
- Seeds or plants
- Spoon
- Fairy garden accessories
 - You can buy or make these!
- Pebbles, glass gems, moss, glitter, other decorations

Instructions

1. Paint your pot using your paint and paintbrushes
2. When the paint is dry, put a layer of rocks in the bottom. Then fill to about an inch or two below the pot top with potting soil.
3. Start to put in your decorations, accessories and plants. You can make some pieces to put into your garden if you'd like or you can buy some.
4. Once you are finished decorating, if using any seeds, plant them into the soil.
5. Water your fairy garden and put it in a place where it will get sunlight.
