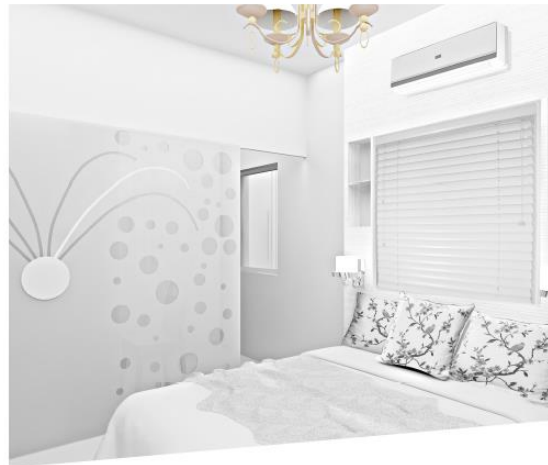

Design Board

Key Concepts

- How to prepare a design board to display samples and materials for your decorating project

Materials

- Computer with internet access to find images
- If you plan on doing this on paper:
 - Large Bristol board
 - Printer and paper
 - Labels or markers
 - Physical samples (if available)
- If you are making this completely on the computer:
 - Processor to compile all your images to arrange them
 - Google slides is a free PowerPoint processor that could be an option
- Pen and paper for marking down ideas

Instructions

1. Choose a room to design (see below the Kitchen example)
2. Choose a color palate and/or theme for the room
 - a. Modern, rustic, farmhouse, colonial, beach, etc.
3. Begin your design
 - a. Flooring, wall treatments, ceilings
 - b. Furniture
 - c. Lighting
 - d. Accents
4. Take a picture/save your finished design and submit it
 - a. Don't forget to tag it
