Youth Safety Policy training is new in 2020. It is being rolled in—it is a requirement for all new 4-H leaders, as well as those that are rescreening. Each 4-H club must have at least two who meet the requirements of a Trained Volunteer (A) to register their club. However, for 2020-21 only, those that meet the A- requirement are able to register as a leader and to supervise activities as an A. All 4-H volunteers are encouraged to take the Youth Safety Training as soon as they are able to reach the A level.
